Purpose of the Role

- Coordinating the Organising Committee (Org Com) and the organisational process of the event

Main Responsibilities

- To chair the Organising Committee (Org Com)
- To coordinate the administrative, financial, marketing, scientific and social aspects of the event

Tasks

Note: These tasks can be delegated to the selected Org Com members.

- Chairing the Org Com
 - Building, structuring and leading the team
 - Reporting to the Events Office and being the liaison between the Org Com and the Events Office in order to ensure an efficient flow of information
 - Ensuring that the Org.Com adheres to EFPSA's Statues, Domestic Regulations, Corporate Visual Identity (CVI), official communication channels and working practices
 - Ensuring the sharing of the Knowledge Transfer, the EFPSA Minimal Requirements and other relevant documents with the Org.Com
 - Ensuring contact with the EFPSA Finance Office and other relevant teams
 - Ensuring that an action plan is made and adhered to and that tasks are delegated accordingly
- Coordinating the administrative aspects
 - Securing a venue fitting the EFPSA Minimal Requirements and the event specific requirements
 - Handling logistical aspects of the event and documentation
 - Providing participants with all necessary information on the website in a timely manner and ensuring adequate, professional and timely communication

- Coordinating the financial aspects
 - Making the preliminary and final budget for the event
 - Searching for potential partners, sponsors, grants or other financial or material support
- Coordinating the marketing aspects
 - Taking care of the external image of the event and ensuring a uniform design for all the materials
 - Preparing and scheduling a promotional wave
- Coordinating the scientific aspects
 - Choosing the topic of the event
 - Looking for and selecting relevant potential speakers, lecturers and active participants
 - Ensuring adequate, professional, and timely communication with the presenters
 - Organising and making the schedule of the scientific programme
- Coordinating the social aspect
 - Providing opportunities for social interaction and network
 - Organising an evening social program
 - Organising an excursion

- Being a psychology student or up-to-2-year psychology graduate in one of countries in the member organisation where EFPSA represented
- Proficient command of English language
- Organisational skills
- Project management skills
- Communication skills
- Leadership skills
